## CAMPAIGN SNAPSHOT

By 2031, CrossPoint will become a sending church with 20 locations, unleashing thousands of Everyday Missionaries to awaken the next 1% of our communities with the hope of Jesus.

To fully realize this vision by 2031, we need to invest significantly in three key areas:

### Financial Freedom (\$3.5M)

Eliminate facility debt to release \$425,000 annually for ministry multiplication.

### Ministry Infrastructure (\$1M)


Strengthen worship environments across 14 locations.

### Multiplication Investment (\$500K)

Launch new church plants through the Harvester Foundation.

### Expected Kingdom Impact:

- \$425,000 annually redirected to direct ministry impact.
- 20 locations across Kansas and beyond.
- Thousands of Everyday Missionaries equipped and sent.
- Enhanced ministry environments at all current locations.
- New church plants multiplying the gospel across the region.



## THE VISION: UNLEASHING EVERYDAY MISSIONARIES

---

CrossPoint Church began as Westbrook Baptist Church in 1970. Our true growth story started in 2002 when Pastor Andy Addis answered the call to shepherd the congregation. Since then, we've grown from 200 to 4,000 weekend attendees and expanded to 14 locations as part of a rural multisite movement.

We serve ordinary people looking for real hope and lasting purpose. Our mission is reaching those disconnected from God by helping them encounter Jesus and live out their faith where they live, learn, work, and play.

**But God isn't finished with us yet.**

**By 2031, CrossPoint will become a sending church with 20 locations, unleashing thousands of Everyday Missionaries to awaken the next 1% of our communities with the hope of Jesus.**

This vision isn't about filling buildings—it's about filling every place with the presence and purpose of God. Through worship gatherings, small groups, serving opportunities, leadership development, and relational disciple-making, we equip people to grow and go, creating a multiplying movement of Everyday Missionaries.

To fully realize this vision by 2031, we need to invest significantly in three key areas: achieving financial freedom from facility debt, developing organizational capacity with strong leaders and teams, and creating operational excellence that removes barriers to bold expansion.



## WHY NOW?

---

This campaign isn't just about good intentions—it's about seizing a strategic moment when God has uniquely prepared us for multiplication.

### **We're Building from Strength, Not Desperation**

At the end of 2025, CrossPoint finished \$350,000 above budget, demonstrating strong financial health and positive giving momentum. This is evidence of God's faithfulness and your generous stewardship. We're launching this campaign from a position of organizational strength, ready to multiply what God has already built.

### **The Harvest Field Is Ripe**

Communities across Kansas are searching for hope. The isolation and disconnection so many experienced in recent years have created unprecedented spiritual openness. People are looking for authentic community and lasting purpose. This is our moment to meet them where they are.

### **Our Systems Are Ready**

We've spent years developing reproducible systems for multisite ministry. Our leaders are trained. Our Training Center is operational. Our discipleship pathway is proven. We're not experimenting—we're multiplying what works.


### **Financial Freedom Changes Everything**

## BIBLICAL FOUNDATION

---

This campaign is built on timeless biblical principles that call us to faithful stewardship, generous giving, and bold multiplication of disciples.

### **The Great Commission: Our Sending Mandate**

*“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”* Matthew 28:19-20

Jesus didn't call us to gather and stay—He called us to go and multiply. The Unleashed campaign positions us to send Everyday Missionaries into communities across Kansas and beyond, fulfilling Christ's command to make disciples wherever we're sent.

### **Prioritizing God's Work**

*“Is it a time for you yourselves to dwell in your paneled houses, while this house lies in ruins?”* Haggai 1:4

God challenged His people to prioritize kingdom work over personal comfort. This campaign calls us to the same faithful priorities—investing in ministry multiplication even when it requires sacrifice.

### **The Multiplication Principle**

*“The point is this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.”* 2 Corinthians 9:6

God promises that generous sowing produces abundant harvest. When we give generously to kingdom work, God multiplies the impact far beyond what we could accomplish through our own resources.

### **Expanding Reach**

*“But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”* Acts 1:8

Jesus envisioned ever-expanding circles of gospel witness. Our multisite vision follows this biblical pattern—starting where we are and extending outward, empowered by the Holy Spirit to reach new communities with the hope of Jesus.



## FROM THE FIELD TO FAITH: A STORY OF NEW LIFE THROUGH CROSSPOINT CHURCH

"My life had always been surrounded by ignorance of who Christ was. I didn't understand why people believed in Him or why He was talked about so much. But everything changed when I came to Hutchinson from Canada to play baseball for Hutchinson Community College. I saw something I'd never seen before—a community filled with joy and peace.

For as long as I could remember, my identity was tied to baseball. My confidence, my mood, even my self-worth rose and fell with my performance on the field. When the game wasn't going well, neither was I. Eventually, that left me in a dark place. I began to ask hard questions: What's my purpose if I can't perform? Who am I if I can't play baseball anymore? Thoughts like those filled my mind with anxiety and hopelessness.

I remember sitting at the airport on my way back to Hutch after Christmas break, unsure if I even wanted to return. I wasn't sure if I wanted to keep playing baseball—or if I had anything left to give. I called my dad, and through tears told him how lost I felt. His words stuck with me: "We'll take life one day at a time." When I got back to Hutch, my heart was still heavy. But one day I picked up a Bible and flipped to a random page. It landed on Matthew 6. As I read, one verse stopped me cold: *"Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own."* — Matthew 6:34

Immediately I thought about what my dad had said—one day at a time. That couldn't just be a coincidence. In that moment, something in me shifted. **I knew God was speaking directly to my heart.**

Soon after, I started attending CrossPoint Church on Sundays and Challenge on Mondays. Through that community, I found friends who pointed me to Jesus and teammates who showed me what it means to walk in faith. I've never looked back since.

In February of 2025, I gave my life to Jesus—and it's the best decision I've ever made. Church and Challenge have helped me grow in ways I never imagined. They've taught me to carry my cross daily and to trust that God has a plan for my life. The community and joy I've found here have strengthened my faith and given me the courage to share my story with others.

**Looking back, I can see God's hand in every detail**—even in that moment at the airport when I didn't know what to do. I thank the Lord for giving me the courage to get on that plane, and for using CrossPoint Church to show me the way, the truth, and the life."

**Stories like this are why we're committed to reaching 20 locations by 2031. This young man found hope at our Hutchinson location. Imagine the hundreds more who will encounter the life-changing hope of Jesus as we expand to six additional communities. Each new location represents countless stories of transformation—lives rescued from darkness, families restored, and everyday people discovering their God-given purpose. Your investment in this campaign multiplies these stories across Kansas and beyond.**



## THE OPPORTUNITY

---

The Unleashed campaign represents three interconnected investments that position CrossPoint for bold multiplication. Each element is essential to realizing our 2031 vision.

### 1. Financial Freedom to Multiply Ministry

Our Hutchinson and Lindsborg facilities currently carry \$3.5 million in debt. These loan payments consume \$425,000 annually—resources that could fuel ministry multiplication instead of servicing debt.

#### **Achieving financial freedom unleashes \$425,000 every year for direct ministry impact:**

- **Launching new locations:** Each new site costs between \$10,000 and \$250,000 to establish
- **Developing leaders:** Recruiting, training, and retaining mission-aligned pastors and team members
- **Expanding discipleship:** Strengthening next-generation ministries and local outreach
- **Multiplying impact:** Giving locations flexibility to respond to ministry opportunities in their communities
- **Building momentum:** Investing in storytelling, communications, and leadership development

This isn't just paying off debt—it's unlocking perpetual ministry multiplication.

### 2. Ministry Infrastructure That Removes Barriers

Effective ministry requires excellent environments. Across our 14 locations, we face facility challenges that limit our capacity to serve:

- Aging infrastructure requiring significant maintenance
- Inadequate children's and student spaces
- Parking and accessibility concerns
- Outdated worship environments
- Limited fellowship and gathering spaces

\$1 million invested across all locations will create welcoming environments that honor God, serve people, and remove obstacles to ministry effectiveness. Each location will steward their portion strategically to enhance their unique ministry context.

### 3. Multiplication Investment Through Church Planting

Our multisite vision extends beyond CrossPoint locations. Through partnership with the Harvester Foundation, \$500,000 will launch new church plants across Kansas and beyond—gospel-centered communities that carry the vision of multiplying Everyday Missionaries into new territories.

These plants represent kingdom expansion beyond what CrossPoint can accomplish alone. We're investing in a movement that multiplies disciples, not just growing a single organization.



## OUR \$5 MILLION VISION

This campaign represents more than a financial goal—it's a faith step toward greater kingdom impact. Together, we're believing God for \$5 million to position CrossPoint for a stronger future: debt-free, mission-focused, and ready to multiply.

### How the \$5 Million Will Be Invested

#### Priority One: \$3,500,000 - Financial Freedom

Eliminate facility obligations to release \$425,000 annually for ministry multiplication. Before we do anything else, we're committed to achieving financial freedom. This foundational step frees future ministry from financial burden and allows resources to flow directly into people, mission, and multiplication.

#### Priority Two: \$1,000,000 - Ministry Infrastructure

Strengthen worship environments and ministry spaces across all 14 CrossPoint locations. Each location will determine how to best steward their portion to create welcoming environments that remove barriers and enhance ministry effectiveness in their unique context.

#### Priority Three: \$500,000 - Multiplication Investment

Launch new church plants through the Harvester Foundation. After addressing the debt, we'll invest half a million dollars through the Harvester Foundation to fuel new church plants across Kansas and beyond. This will help launch gospel-centered communities that carry the CrossPoint vision into new places.

#### Gift Application Strategy

Gifts will be applied to Priority One first, then flow to Priorities Two and Three as we reach each milestone. This ensures we achieve financial freedom before expanding other investments.



***What Financial Freedom Enables***

Imagine redirecting \$425,000 annually—every year—away from loan payments and directly into life change. This isn't just savings; it's fuel for ministry, allowing us to reinvest those dollars directly into mission-critical areas that strengthen our church today and prepare us for the future.

Here's how we'll steward this ongoing ministry multiplier:

**Sustain Capital Improvement and Facility Projects - \$150,000 annually**

The \$1.4 million remaining after debt elimination gives us a launch pad for future endeavors, but without annual fuel for our many facilities, we'll continue facing unplanned repairs and lack flexibility to improve our spaces. This investment ensures our facilities remain excellent, welcoming environments that honor God and serve people, while making future debt a last resort.

**Strengthen Local Discipleship and Ministry - \$100,000 annually**

While personnel remains our greatest investment, ministry growth is essential to our 2031 vision. This funding expands next-generation ministries, invests in outreach and mission opportunities at each location, and equips sites with flexibility to make disciples effectively in their unique contexts.

**Expand Leadership Development & Training - \$75,000 annually**

The Training Center is critical to multiplying Everyday Missionaries. These funds build out core training workshops twice yearly at all locations, create leader development programs for staff, residents, interns, and bi-vocational leaders, and offer scholarships for leadership development opportunities and conferences.

**Communications & Storytelling Infrastructure - \$75,000 annually**

Effective storytelling inspires engagement and multiplies impact. This investment ensures dedicated staff and creative resources to capture and share stories of life change, sustains campaign-level communication excellence beyond the campaign, and strengthens evangelism and connection pathways.

**Local Ministry Flex Fund - \$25,000 annually**

A dedicated pool for location pastors enables contextualized outreach and seed projects. This ensures financial freedom feels tangible at every campus, empowering local leaders to respond to ministry opportunities as they arise.

***This annual reallocation transforms loan payments into lasting ministry momentum—every single year.***

### 2025 Financial Highlights:

- **Income exceeded budget by \$718K**, driven by consistent General Fund giving and a strong Q4 finish.
- **Expenses increased in proportion to ministry activity**, facilities usage, and operational scale, while remaining well below income growth.
- **Personnel investment** stayed closely aligned with budget, reflecting disciplined staffing and benefit management.
- **Local ministry and outreach spending exceeded plan**, signaling expanded ministry impact and engagement.
- The year closed with a **net operating surplus of \$350,878**, strengthening reserves and positioning the church well for future vision initiatives.

## BROKENNESS AND BOUNDLESS GRACE

"If you had told me a few years ago that my spouse and I would be standing here together today, I wouldn't have believed you. Like many couples, our marriage began with hope, but somewhere along the way the foundation crumbled. We became two broken people living under the same roof, distant and hurting.

Eventually the pain became too much. The marriage we fought for fell apart, and we finalized the divorce. It was the lowest point in my life, a profound failure, a deep grief, and a future I never expected to face. The family I cherished was shattered, and I felt completely undone.

It was in that place of absolute brokenness that everything changed. Alone, desperate, and unable to see any path forward, I walked into a church and simply began begging God to fix what I had ruined. I didn't ask Him to fix my spouse; I asked Him to fix me. I devoted myself to seeking His presence, reading His Word, and learning to lean on His strength. That journey of finding my identity in Christ was the turning point that changed everything.

### **And that's when God's incredible power became unmistakable.**

As He began to transform my heart, not through my effort but through His grace, the distance between us started to soften. There was no dramatic moment or overnight miracle. It was a slow, steady work of the Holy Spirit in both of our lives. We began talking again, not as adversaries, but as two people who had individually experienced God's healing.

Step by step, prayer by prayer, we found our way back to each other and back home as a family. Today, our marriage is stronger than it has ever been because it's built on the solid rock of Christ rather than our own fragile efforts. We are doing great, not because we are perfect, but because we serve a perfect God.

We are eternally grateful for His hand in our restoration. If God can take the finality of a divorce decree and rewrite it into a story of grace, He can do anything. Our greatest blessing now is the opportunity to share that nothing, absolutely nothing, is too broken for God to heal."

## WAYS TO GIVE

---

At CrossPoint Church, our greatest motivation for giving is advancing the cause of Christ. Every gift fuels ministry, supports outreach, and helps more people encounter the hope of Jesus. Your most effective giving strategy depends on your unique situation. Many donors find that giving appreciated assets or real estate allows them to give more generously while receiving significant tax benefits. We encourage you to consult your financial advisor about which approach best serves both your giving goals and financial stewardship.

### 1. Cash Gifts

The simplest and most direct way to give is through cash. Your gift can be made using:

- Cash, personal checks, or cashier's checks
- Automatic transfers from your checking or savings account
- Credit or debit cards

### 2. Gifts of Appreciated Assets

Giving appreciated securities—such as stocks or bonds—can be a wise and generous choice. When transferred directly to CrossPoint Church before being sold, these gifts may offer **significant tax advantages**:

- You may qualify for an income tax deduction for the full market value of the asset.
- You avoid paying capital gains tax on the appreciated value.

**Example:** Tom and Sarah owned stock purchased 15 years ago for \$10,000, now worth \$50,000. By transferring it directly to CrossPoint, they avoided \$6,000 in capital gains tax and received a \$50,000 charitable deduction—enabling them to give \$50,000 at a net cost of approximately \$32,000.

### 3. Gifts of Real Estate

Donating property—such as a personal residence, vacation home, income property, or vacant land—offers a unique opportunity to make a lasting difference. When held for more than one year, these gifts can allow you to:

- Deduct the full fair market value of the property
- Avoid paying capital gains tax on appreciated value

This form of giving can be especially impactful for both the giver and the mission of CrossPoint Church. As always, contact your tax advisor with any questions.

### 4. Gifts of Tangible Personal Property

Items of significant value—such as artwork, rare books, collectibles, or other tangible assets—can also serve as meaningful gifts. When appropriately appraised and given for ministry use, these items can provide both a charitable deduction and a way to invest in eternal impact.

Read and discuss scriptures such as Proverbs 3:9-10, Luke 6:38, and 2 Corinthians 9:6-12. This is a powerful opportunity to teach faith and stewardship together as a household.

Regarding a cash gift:

- How much could we gather by the campaign deadline?
- Is there anything we could sell or convert to cash?

Regarding a 36-month commitment:

- Could we reduce any current expenses to increase our gift?
- Are there expenditures we could delay?
- How might we increase our income to make a greater impact?
- What amount would stretch our faith?


#### **3. Commit**

## LOCATION MINISTRY PLANS

---

Each CrossPoint location will steward its portion of the \$1 million facility investment to create welcoming environments that remove barriers and enhance ministry effectiveness in its unique context. Here's how locations plan to invest these resources:

### Hays

CrossPoint Hays plans to repair and improve the southeast parking lot, addressing issues with drainage, surface damage, and access. This project will allow full use of the rear entrance, enhance safety for vehicles and pedestrians, and demonstrate our commitment to excellence in caring for our facility. It will also prepare our grounds for future growth and expansion.

### Salina

CrossPoint Salina will make significant upgrades to our family ministry spaces and invest intentionally in improved parking logistics. These improvements will create a more welcoming, functional, and safe environment for families and guests.

### Great Bend

CrossPoint Great Bend plans to remodel the kitchen and fellowship hall, as well as update the flooring and finishes in the main bathrooms. These enhancements will help create a more inviting and functional space for ministry gatherings and community connection.

### Sterling

CrossPoint Sterling plans to refinish the floors throughout the facility and update the kitchen area. These improvements will refresh high-use spaces, improve functionality, and better support our growing ministry needs.

### Concordia

CrossPoint Concordia will use its spring giving campaign funds to make key facility improvements that enhance our space for worship, fellowship, and community engagement. Your generosity will directly impact how we serve and connect with those in our city.

### Lindsborg

CrossPoint Lindsborg will upgrade the lighting in our Worship Center. These improvements will enhance the visual experience, improve projector visibility, and provide greater control and flexibility during services. Your generosity helps us create a more welcoming and engaging atmosphere for everyone who gathers here.

### Pittsburg

CrossPoint Pittsburg will update carpet and make other facility improvements in our Worship Center and children's area to make the spaces more functional and welcoming.

### Hutchinson

CrossPoint Hutchinson plans to repair and resurface the parking lot to create a safe, welcoming environment that reflects the care and excellence we aim to demonstrate in every area of ministry. This improvement will also strengthen our first impression for guests and the community.

### Ellsworth

CrossPoint Ellsworth will invest additional facilities funds into developing dedicated kids and youth spaces within a new facility. These upgrades will help us create a more engaging, age-appropriate environment for next-generation ministry.

### Topeka

CrossPoint Topeka plans to resurface and re-line the parking lot, improving safety, accessibility, and overall appearance. This investment supports a better experience for guests and members alike.

### Russell

CrossPoint Russell will renovate the welcome area to include seating and space for serving small meals before Sunday services. This update will foster connection, conversation, and community among those attending each week.

### Liberal

CrossPoint Liberal will use this additional financial support to help build a new kitchen. This project will strengthen our capacity to host meals, outreach events, and ministry programs—creating a clean, efficient, and welcoming space for both our congregation and community.

### Iola

CrossPoint Iola will continue onboarding as one of our newest locations, focusing on facility updates that help it reflect the look and feel of a CrossPoint Church. These improvements will create a consistent, welcoming environment that aligns with our shared identity and mission.

### McPherson

CrossPoint McPherson will use this season to prepare for a permanent facility. As a currently rented location, we will focus on strategic planning, resource development, and readiness steps that position us well for a future long-term home where ministry can flourish and expand.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### **What if I can't fulfill my pledge?**

We understand that life circumstances can change unexpectedly. If you face financial difficulties that prevent you from fulfilling your commitment, simply contact our church office. There's no penalty or judgment—we're grateful for whatever you're able to contribute.

### **Can I give monthly instead of weekly?**

Absolutely! You can fulfill your commitment through weekly, monthly, quarterly, or annual gifts—whatever schedule works best for your financial planning.

### **Can I designate my gift to a specific location?**

Campaign gifts support the overall Unleashed vision, which benefits all locations. However, if you have specific designation requests, please contact Support Team to discuss options.

### **What if we exceed the \$5 million goal?**

Additional funds beyond \$5 million will be directed toward accelerating our 2031 vision—funding additional location launches, expanding the Training Center, and strengthening our mission mobilization efforts.

### **How will we track progress?**

We'll provide regular updates through weekend services, email communications, and visual displays showing our progress toward the goal. We'll celebrate milestones together as we advance toward financial freedom and multiplication readiness.

### **Should I continue my regular giving?**

Yes! Campaign commitments are above and beyond your regular tithes and offerings. Continuing your regular giving ensures we sustain current ministry while building capacity for future multiplication.

### **Can I make an anonymous gift?**

Yes. While we track all gifts for tax and campaign purposes, you can request that your contribution remain anonymous within the congregation.

### **What happens after we pay off the debt?**

Once financial freedom is achieved, campaign gifts flow to Priorities Two (facility improvements) and Three (church planting). Additionally, the \$425,000 previously used for loan payments immediately redirects to ongoing ministry multiplication as outlined in "The Ministry Multiplier" section.
